What is a RHIP?

It's a process improvement project that delivers results quickly by targeting areas which have high impact and ease of implementation.

Why Launch a RHIP?

- To get quick results
- To challenge current policies and rules
- To assess the efficacy of current metrics
- To engage people
- To address leadership skepticism

What's involved?

- A customer focused, process based view
- Intense cross functional, project team meetings
- Executive engagement and rapid action

What's a typical schedule?

- 1 – 2 weeks of data gathering
- 3 days of intense meetings over 1 to 2 weeks

- Recommended changes discussed during a 1 to 2 hour meeting with executives

What it is NOT?

- It's not bureaucratic
- It's not focused on IT issues
- It's not about finger pointing
- It's not a committee

What are some typical results?

- Increase in customer value creation
- Cycle time compression
- Cost reduction

How are results achieved?

- Updated policies
- Reduced reviews
- Reduced waiting
- Reduced hand-offs
- Reduced approvals
